Eligibility for the Programme:

- · All applicants must have a Bachelor's degree or Master from an accredited university.
- Work experience / graduate degrees are not required for admission.
- Applicants will be expected to have strong quantitative skills.

Scholarship and Living Stipend

Scholarships cover the whole amount of the tuition fees: €15,400 for the firstyear and €13,500 per year for the subsequent years. In addition the school offers some stipends to cover living expenses during the program. Access to scholarships and stipends is competitive for the first year (MRes) and automatic for the three subsequent years upon satisfactory progress in the program.
